IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

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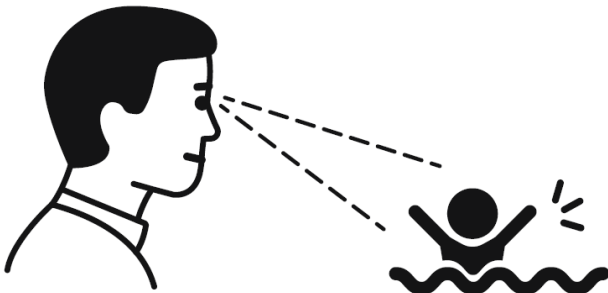
READ, FOLLOW AND UNDERSTAND ALL INSTRUCTIONS AND WARNINGS.

Carefully read and follow all information in this user manual before installing and using the ladder. These warnings, instructions, and safety guidelines address some common risks of water recreation, but they cannot cover all risks and dangers in all cases. Always use caution, common sense and good judgment when enjoying any water activity. Retain this information for future use.



WARNING

Prevent Drowning



Children under 5 are at highest risk for drowning.
Closely watch children who are in or near this pool.



WARNING

No Diving



You can break your neck and be paralyzed.

WATER SAFETY

PREVENT UNAUTHORIZED ACCESS

DANGER: RISK OF ACCIDENTAL DROWNING. Extreme caution must be exercised to prevent unauthorized access by children. To avoid accidents, ensure that children cannot use this ladder unless they are supervised at all times.

WARNING: When pool is not occupied, remove and secure the ladder to prevent access.

Important:

- A barrier is necessary and often required by law, regulation or standard to provide protection against potential drowning and near drowning; however, barriers are not a substitute for the constant supervision of children. Adult supervision is always required.

SAFE USE OF THE LADDER

WARNING: To prevent entrapment or drowning do not swim through, behind, or around ladder.

Important:

- Only use the ladder for entering and exiting the pool.
- Pool users should swim and play away from the ladder area.
- Always check ladder assembly screws and retention clips before use.

CAUTION: Enter and exit the pool slowly and cautiously. Wet surfaces can be slippery.

Entry/Exit:

- For entry / exit of pool, face the ladder at all times.
- Only allow one person on the ladder at a time.

This ladder is designed and manufactured for a specific pool wall height. Ensure this ladder is only used with a pool of the appropriate wall height.

KNOW THE RISKS

Stay informed:

PARTS & TOOLS

You will need a Phillips head screwdriver and an adjustable wrench (not included).

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Set Up

Locate the ladder on a solid base.

The ladder shall be installed per the instructions.

Installation Instructions

For installation instructions, follow the illustrations in the back of the manual. Drawings are for illustration purposes only. May not reflect actual product. Not to scale.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

Always remember to check the ladder before each use. Change the screws or retention clips if there is any rust.

DISASSEMBLY & STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Make sure the ladder is clean and dry before storing. Place it in a cool, dry location out of children's reach.

Winterization Instructions

Remove the ladder from the swimming pool during the off-season (winter months). Carefully disassemble all the components and dry thoroughly.
